

3. EDUCATION VISA APPLICATION PROCESS

A citizen of a foreign country, who wishes to study in Türkiye, must enter Türkiye on an education

visa.

Application Procedure:

1. Assemble the required documents listed below.
2. Start an online application on www.visa.gov.tr and upload the documents when prompted.
3. Print out and sign the application form.
4. After submitting the application successfully, schedule an appointment for the interview which will take place at the Consulate.
5. Be present at the Consulate on the day of the interview with the hard copies of all required documents listed below.

Required Documents:

1. passport and copy of your passport
 - a) Six-month validity for your intended stay.
 - b) with a blank page to affix the visa.
2. The application form
3. One recent passport photo - size (2" x 2")
4. Original and the copy of your green card or your valid US visa. (for NON-US applicants only)
 - Valid I-20 or the letter from school is required for the student visa holders.
 - B1/B2 visa holders can only apply for an education visa at their country of residence.
5. Student ID and/or the acceptance letter from the university at which you wish to study.
6. Your recent transcript if you are currently a student.
 - If you are a graduate, you must submit your diploma.
7. Certificate of good conduct (If you are applying to attend a Turkish Language School)
8. Proof of travel health/accident insurance, valid through duration of stay, including:
 - a) minimum coverage of 30,000 Euros or equivalent USD
 - b) transfer of the patient to nearest healthcare facility or residency address after discharge

and transfer of body in case of death,

9. Most recent bank account statement. (minimum \$5000 balance-if you will bring your sponsor's

bank statement, bring a letter along with financial document stating they will sponsor you)

10. Non-refundable visa fee

- Single Entry: \$60.00 (\$185.00 USA citizens).
- Multiple Entry: \$180.00 (\$265.00 USA citizens).

Optional: A pre-paid envelope (USPS mail carrier)

(Turkish Consulate General in Houston is not responsible for any delivery issues)

Important Notes:

- Your education visa will have 90-day stay only. You must apply for a residence permit on <https://e-ikamet.goc.gov.tr> which will allow you to stay beyond that period.
- Applicants are required to bring hard copies of the documents on the day of the interview.
- In the event that neither Turkish nor English is spoken, every applicant is required to arrange for a translator to accompany them to their interview. Failure to do so will result in rescheduling the appointment with the stipulation that a translator must be present.
- Screenshots will not be accepted. Documents are requested in their original size.
- The documents such as travel insurance, flight and hotel reservations must contain the name and surname of the applicant/s.
- It is strongly advised for applicants to apply **at least one month(during summer season at least 3 month)** prior to their intended trip.
- In individual cases, the applicant may be required to provide additional documents which may delay the visa issuance.
- Turkish Consulate General in Houston **cannot expedite a visa application.**
- Please do not finalize your travel arrangements until you are notified about the outcome of your visa application.
